Beginning to Intermediate Photography is a multi level class with an emphasis on the photographic principles and the use of the wet darkroom. Students from beginner to intermediate will be challenged to gain greater understanding of subject matter and image content. The "Zone" system of exposure will be taught in detail, giving you greater control over your negatives and prints. Contrast control will be taught through the use of film developing, filterization, and advanced darkroom techniques. This class will culminate with a fun and support group critique night.
